#### Case of Splenectomy

"I was in extreme pain, we came to Sohail Trust Hospital, now my pain is gone and I am feeling much better". Zubaida Bibi 68 years old, wife of a security guard mother of 8 children was diagnosed with Splenectomy, she stayed 14 days in the Hospital, total treatment expenses were paid by the Hospital.



#### Case of Inguinal Hernia

Ali Muhammad 50 years old, was admitted in Sohail Trust Hospital, and he was diagnosed with Inguinal Hernia, he has 7 family members to support, he was admitted for 12 days, all of his treatment was provided free by the Hospital.

#### Case of Cholelithiasis

35 years old Shazia Manzoor was admitted at Sohail Trust Hospital for 8 days, she was diagnosed with Cholelithiasis, she is a mother of 4 children and her husband has a kiosk of fruit chat. Total expenses of her treatment were born by Hospital.

#### Case of Enlarge Prostate



"I was suffering from such intense pain, I was worried for the treatment cost but Sohail Trust Hospital became my hope" 69 years old Khalil-ur-Rehman was diagnosed with Enlarge Prostate; he was admitted for 11 days, his free treatment was provided by Hospital.

The event was started by recitation of Holy Quran by Dr. Shariq Mukaram, Dr. Urooj Riaz leaded the session and discussed about the Importance of World Heart Day and why we celebrate it.

Prof. Dr. S.M Inkisar Ali and Vice Chancellor Sohail University, Prof. Dr. Syed Jamshed Ali Kazmi were invited as the chief guest for the event, while addressing the importance of healthy heart, Prof. Dr. S.M Inkisar Ali said "Heart disease is deadly and one of the highest contributor of global deaths, its even higher than combine deaths cause by aids and cancer, healthy diet, simple lifestyle modification and daily 30 mins exercise can significantly reduce the chances of heart disease". The guests also discussed about the increasing patients of cardiac disease in the country due to poor diet and lifestyle. ## Introduction of Typhoid Conjugate Vaccine

Department of Pediatrics, in collaboration with EPI, Govt. of Sindh, organized a program "Introduction of Typhoid conjugate vaccine". Professor S.M. Inkisar Ali coordinator while Asst. Prof. Dr. Uzma Arshad, Department of Pediatric, was the moderator of the program. A large number of the audience included doctors, senior nursing & paramedic staff attended the program.







#### Workshop on Neonatal Resuscitation

Sohail Trust Hospital organized workshop Neonatal Resuscitation. More than 30 participants including doctors & staff were participated in the event. Head of Pediatric Department, Prof. S.M Inkisar Ali while emphasized the importance of event said that timely and effective neonatal resuscitation cannot be over emphasized. Globally, around 4 million neonatal deaths occur every year, out of these more than a million new born die on their first day of life. Further more, 93% of deaths occur in low and middle-income countries including Pakistan. About 25% of all neonatal deaths are caused by birth asphyxia, he added. He also emphasized that birth asphyxia can be effectively treated to a very large extent with timely resuscitation of new born and failure to do so will result in mortality and long-term neuro developmental disability. Prof. Inkisar praised services of senior pediatrician Dr. Habiba Hassan. She thanked Sohail Trust Hospital and presented review on the subject. At the end of event, Q/A's session was conducted and certificates were distributed among participants and facilitators.




